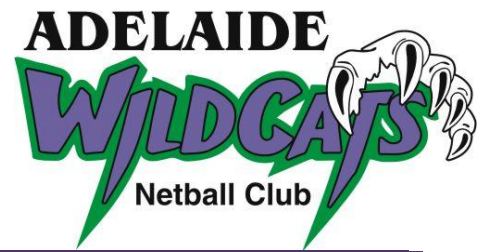

TO HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO BE PLACED IN A TEAM, PLAYERS WILL NEED TO PARTICIPATE IN WINTER TRIALS ON THE DATES/TIMES ABOVE.	
Following trials, players will be placed, where possible, in a squad (if applicable) or a team. Final team gradings will be subject to the AMND Grading Committee. You will be notified by email when teams have been chosen. If you disagree with the placement, you must lodge an appeal with the Secretary within 5 days on receipt of the email. If there is a change of time, details will be posted on Team App and Club Facebook and Instagram pages.

FEE & REFUND INFORMATION

All registrations to trial/play must be completed online through our club's *PlayHQ Platform*.

NOTE: Registration Fees are required to be paid in full via the PlayHQ site at the time of registration, if payment is not complete prior to Trial 1, you/your child will be unable to participate in trials.

FEES

- INTERMEDIATE (born 2008 and 2009), JUNIOR (born 2010 and 2011), SUBJUNIOR (born 2012 and 2013), PRIMARY (born 2014 and 2015) & Sub PRIMARY (born 2016 – 03/05/2018) **\$340***
- SENIOR (born 2007 and earlier) **\$390***

*At the time of payment, an annual Netball SA Membership fee (Seniors \$144.25 includes GST, Juniors \$111.50 includes GST) will be charged, these are **inclusive** in the Club's listed registration fee. These fees are charged and are valid for all competitions in SA for the period 1 April 2025 until 31 March 2026.

REFUNDS

Please be aware that if a player:

- Withdraws after registration but prior to the final trial commencing, the season fee will be refunded less a \$100 registration fee.
- If a player subsequently withdraws at any stage after the completion of the final trial, no refund will be provided.
- If a player cannot be placed in a team, their fees will be refunded in full.
- All refunds will be processed approximately 4 weeks from final teams being confirmed. Netball SA Membership Fees are refundable upon submission of form available from the Club Secretary.

FAMILY DISCOUNT

The discount is applied to the younger family member first. If you are unsure of the application of the discount, you should contact the treasurer (treasurer@adelaidewildcats.com.au) prior to trials to determine the correct amount of payment.

SPORTS VOUCHER

A Government Sports Vouchers ARE accepted.

If you wish to use the Sports Voucher, please complete details on the final screen headed 'Payment & Summary' under the heading 'I have a Government Voucher' on the bottom right-hand corner. Don't forget to include the player's individual Reference Number located on the Medicare card to make a total of 11 digits.

TRIAL & TEAM SELECTION INFORMATION

SENIOR (born 2007 and earlier), INTERMEDIATE (born 2008 and 2009), JUNIOR (born 2010 and 2011), SUBJUNIOR (born 2012 and 2013), PRIMARY (born 2014 and 2015) & Sub PRIMARY (born 2016 – 03/05/2018) players:

- Attendance at trials for these grades will ensure team selection is made based on a player's ability.
- Final team selections will be made based on the ability of players as demonstrated at trials, the balance of court positions and with past experience being taken into some consideration if required.

Team Selections will be advised via email to the address provided at registration as soon as possible after the trial process. It is important to read all the information in the team selection email and formally accept the position offered.

Please note that registration and trialling does not guarantee selection in a team. The club reserves the right not to nominate teams if the mix of player positions is not suitable, or if we have insufficient volunteers to coach teams.
